

School Levy

As you are aware St. Bernadette's is a Catholic Voluntary Aided school. This means that while the Government provides money for staff wages, books and equipment, the building costs and repairs are paid for by the Archdiocese of Liverpool.

All Catholic schools in the diocese are requested to pay an equal share of money towards the building fund.

Therefore we respectfully request parents to pay a voluntary contribution of £10.00 per year per child, or per family if you have more than one child.

This week we have sent home a reminder of this via our school APP where you can make your contribution via your Parentpay account. Alternatively, payments will be gratefully received through the school office.

Free School Meals

You may not be aware that schools receive additional funding depending on the number of children eligible for free school meals.

If you think your child may qualify for free school meals then the school could benefit if you apply — even if you choose to provide packed lunches.

If your financial circumstances have changed and you think you may be eligible, please visit: <u>Free school meals, pupil premium, and EYPP (wigan.gov.uk)</u> to check eligibility and apply.

A form has also been sent home to collect information. We ask you fill this in and return it to school ASAP so we can check potential funding for St Bernadette's.
