#### **Year 1 Lenten Reflection**

The Year 1 children led a beautiful Lenten reflection last week, where they focussed on the themes of kindness and giving, fasting and prayer. They shared ways in which they could show care for others and make small sacrifices throughout this season. It was a thoughtful reflection that brought the school together and inspired us all.

Thank you to all the children who took part in our second Lenten Market and the support they received from home. They came together to support each other and raise funds for CAFOD. We look forward to continuing our fundraising efforts throughout Lent.

#### **Easter WOW Week**

The last week of this term sees the return of our annual Easter WOW Week.

The week begins with an hour-long prayer journey. The children will visit prayer stations helping them to empathise with the journey Jesus took to the cross.

Throughout the rest of the week, children will grow a deeper understanding of the Easter story through RE lessons and a range of practical activities such as art and crafts and dance. They will help the children learn about the events of Holy Week through fun and hands-on experiences.

#### **Stations of the Cross**

On <u>Tuesday 1st April</u>, our Year 3-6 classes will be participating in the 9:15am Mass at St. Bernadette's Church which will focus on the Stations of the Cross.

The Stations of the Cross is a solemn and reflective journey that retraces the steps of Jesus Christ on the day of his crucifixion. It is a powerful and spiritual experience that provides our children with an opportunity for deep reflection and understanding of the significance of Easter.

Parents and family members are invited to join us and are welcome to walk to church from school on this morning.
